

STAFFORDSHIRE A.A.A. CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS 2024

The Championships will be held at Betley Court Farm, Main Road, Betley, CW3 9BH, on Saturday 6th January 2024.

1. Eligibility:

- a) Athletes who were born, or who have lived for the previous nine months, including by service in a Unit ofHMForces, within the County boundaries (pre 1964), or who have previously acquired and exercised eligibility and not competed subsequently for another County. (See UKA ruleG2S6)
- b) Athletes must be a current member of a first claim club, with up to date EA Registration.
- 2. The Age Groups are defined as follows:

Under 13 Girls and Boys	Born 01.09.10 to 31.08.12
Under 15 Girls and Boys	Born 01.09.08 to 31.08.10
Under 17 Women and Men	Born 01.09.06 to 31.08.08
Under 20 Women and Men	Born 01.09.03 to 31.08.06
Senior Men and Women	Born on or before 31.08.03

Masters Women Must be at least 35 years old on the date of competition Masters Men Must be at least 35 years old on the date of competition

All entrants must give date of birth to be eligible for Age Group medals. Please refer to the separate Privacy Statement.

3. Competition Categories:

Male Open (All except Female Category) Female (from Birth)

- 4. Under 13 Girls and Boys will start together and run the same distance to a single finish funnel. Under 15 Girls and Boys will start together and run the same distance to a single finish funnel. U17 Men, U17 Women, U20 Women, Senior and Masters Women will start together and run the same distance to a single finish funnel. U20 Men, Senior and Masters Men will run as one race, a cut-off time of twice the winner's time will be in operation, which the Referee may impose at the start of the final lap.
- 5. Awards will be made to the first three in each race. Only clubs affiliated to the county will be eligible for TeamAwards, with three to count, except for Senior &Masters Women, where four will count and Senior &Masters Men, where six will count. Under 20s will count in the Open Team, as will Masters. Under 20s and Veterans will receive Individual and Team Awards based on their position in the Open race.
- 6. Awards will be presented as soon as possible after each race.
- 7. Individual entry fees are £7.00 for Seniors and Masters, £5.00 for U20, U17, U15 and U13. There are no team entry fees.

For any personal data that is provided to us for the purposes of administering your participation in the County Cross Country Championships, STAFFORDSHIRE AAA is the Data Controller and is responsible for storing and otherwise processing that data in a fair, lawful, secure and transparent way.

What personal data we hold on you

Team Managers, or the individual athlete, will be required to provide the URN, name, gender and date of birth for athletes entered in the County Cross Country Championships. Once these Championships have taken place we will collect and process race results for these Cross Country Championships.

Why we need your personal data

The reason we need collect athlete data is to pursue the legitimate interest of the County Association and its affiliated clubs and to deliver athletics competition in accordance with the rules of the sport. Data will be used:

- to check athlete registration against data already provided to England Athletics, thus confirming the athlete's eligibility to compete
- to publish your Personal Information as part of the results of the Event and may pass such information to the Governing Body or any Affiliated Organisation for the purpose of insurance, licences or for publishing results for the event alone, or combined with, or compared to other events. Results will include the Athletes Name, Gender, Age Category, Club Affiliation and Race Time.

Who we share your personal data with

This information will not be shared with any third party, other than England Athletics.

How long we hold your personal data

The Staffordshire AAA County Cross Country Championships database containing the athletes Dates of Birth will only be retained for 1 year.

Your rights regarding your personal data

As a data subject you may have the right at any time to request access to, rectification or erasure of your personal data; to restrict or object to certain kinds of processing of your personal data, including direct marketing; to the portability of your personal data and to complain to the UK's data protection supervisory authority, the Information Commissioner's Office about the processing of your personal data.
